CODE OF CONDUCT

As a pupil/student taking part in activities at Tyn Dwr you are considered to be a representative of UCLan and as such are asked to observe sensible standards of behaviour at all times. During sessions and when on activities:

- Follow all instructions given to you by the staff working with you.
- Wear all personal protective equipment identified.
- Avoid touching any equipment other than when told to do so, by the staff working with you.
- Stay with your group, unless told otherwise by your leaders.
- Assemble as instructed in order to receive specific instructions regarding safety.
- Wear sensible clothing and footwear as advised.
- No mobile phones or personal stereo's are permitted whilst on activities.

General behaviour

- Follow the strict no smoking policy in all buildings, designated areas will be identified.
- Respect the surrounding areas and surrounding neighbours.
- Keep the environment tidy, do not drop litter and use all bins provided.
- Look after the environment; do not disturb wildlife or plants.
- Chewing gum is not permitted.
